***Seniors**, note that completion of the FAFSA is required for most scholarships—not just need based ones.

***Please Note** – Students interested in applying to “Ivy League” type colleges such as Harvard, Georgetown, Pennsylvania State University, Duke, Stanford, etc. are cautioned about frequently taking the ACT and SAT. Representatives from these colleges say their admission officers question as to why a student feels the need to take it more than once or twice.

***Transcripts:** At different times during the year, your senior may need a copy of his/her transcript to send to colleges or to include with scholarship applications.
